

Race Management

Race Officer

The attention of the Race Officer is drawn to the instructions in the Club House, regarding their duties. In the event of the R.O. not being able to attend on the date shown, it is the individual's responsibility to arrange a substitute from the list and to notify the Sailing Secretary of the change.

The Hon. Sailing Secretary should normally confirm exchanges of duties, but generally a nominated Race Officer may exchange duty with another nominated Race Officer. Please consult the Hon. Sailing Secretary before proposing any other change of duty.

There will be a meeting of the Race Officer, Sailing Secretary and Class Captains each Sunday & Bank Holidays to consider that days racing. This will include a discussion on courses and weather. Any decision to postpone or cancel racing will be made by the Group attending. Any final decision to cancel racing should not be made before 11.00 a.m.

The meeting will take place at 9.30 a.m. at the Race Board.

Support Boat Crew

Will report to the Race Officer and sign the attendance sheet, at the following **latest** times and if unable to attend shall arrange a substitute: If there is not enough support boat crew, a board will be raised on the bridge and no racing will take place until all support boats are manned.

Members should arrange a substitute if unable to attend. The support boats must be left prepared at all times and defects reported to the Club Boatswain, Sailing Secretary or Race Officer immediately.
